CANADIAN SEMESTER ABROAD

CRITERIA

- ⇒ First Year Students Divisions of The Hospitality Institute and Fine Arts (must have a GPA of 3.0 and above;
- ⇒ Passport must be valid until July 2022 or later;
- ⇒ Students must be 18 by August 1, 2021 to be eligible;
- ⇒ *Applicants must submit a one page typed Letter of Intent describing the nature of your studies to be undertaken and explaining the rationale for study in Canada. Also indicate how the proposed program of study will relate to your future career/country.
- ⇒ Students must also submit with their application, a passport-sized photograph and a photocopy of their passport (biographical information).



THE DEADLINE FOR APPLICATIONS IS MARCH 11, 2021



The selected students are hosted through a home stay programme which is organized by the Canadian Institution for 1 semester—Emerging Leaders in the Americas Program (ELAP) scholarship. Scholarship winners are awarded a sum of CAD \$7,200.00 to cover airfare, accommodation, food and administrative fees during the students' stay in Canada.

The credits earned in Canada will be transferred to the students' academic records at BCC.

Students with a GPA of less than 3.0 are not eligible for this scholarship

Applicants should note that they may have to apply for extended studies in order to complete the Associate Degree programme.

Note also that we are still in an unprecedented time and the University may have to withdraw the application at a later time if it cannot provide in-classroom learning or travel restriction become more rigorous.
